NOTICE FROM IRISH MARITIME DEVELOPMENT OFFICE

FERRY SERVICES TO UK AND FRANCE FROM IRISH PORTS

In light of the continued difficulties with aviation travel in Ireland and Europe we would like to advise passengers of all alternative ferry passenger services available from the island of Ireland.

There are currently six operators offering direct passenger services from five ports in Ireland to nine ports in the United Kingdom, **giving an average of sixty sailing per day**. Additional sailings have been added from Cork to Swansea.

There are also three operators providing direct passenger services from Ireland to France, with seven sailings per week to Cherbourg and Roscoff in the North of France.

There are varying degrees of foot and car capacity available and passengers who have flexibility with their travel should find more alternatives. Passengers should check directly with all shipping operators here under for further details.
